IMPORTER SECURITY FILING

- In recent outreach events, Customs has emphasized that it expects importers to begin filing the required 10 Importer Security Filing (ISF) data elements when the Interim Final Rule goes into effect on January 26, 2009, even though enforcement extends only to six of the elements. Customs will be generating performance reports on filers that will be distributed and considered in 2010 when full enforcement begins.
- Customs continues to hold ISF outreach events. Space is FTR ENFORCEMENT limited and Customs encourages interested parties to register "Guidelines" online.
