The 2008 Farm Bill amendments to the Lacev Act requiring importers to declare the species of plants used to produce imported products are scheduled to go into effect December 15, 2008, with enforcement provisions phased-in beginning April 1, 2009. While the requirement potentially covers a broad array of products, planned phase-in of implementations by HTSUS Chapter begins with Chapters 44 94, and inter-agency discussions are continuing. document clarifying issues such rushed exemptions for "common certification cultivars," the treatment of hang tags and instruction manuals, and development. 73 Fed.
