EXPORT DIVERSION/UAE

The Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) has proposed a new rule to create a Country Group "C" consisting of countries that are "Destinations of Diversion Concern." The countries will be identified based on prior diversion issues, insufficient controls, lack of cooperation, etc. Insiders have indicated that the rule is aimed at countries like the United Arab Emirates (UAE), where the U.S. government believes serious diversion issues exist. The UAE (Dubai, Abu Dhabi, et al.) is developing already stronger export controls to address U.S. concerns, and avoid being placed in the proposed country group. 72 Fed. Reg. 8315 (Feb. 26, 2007).
