## **CHINA TRADE**

- The U.S. Dept. of Commerce issued а preliminary determination that China has provided countervailable subsidies to exports of coated free sheet paper. This breaks precedent by applying countervailing duty law to China's non-market economy. 72 Fed. Reg. <u>17484</u> (April 9, 2007).
- The U.S. has requested WTO consultations over China's inadequate protection copyrights and trademarks, and Chinese market barriers legitimately trademarked goods create а market counterfeit products.
