FTZ BOARD HEARING

On April 18, 2007, the U.S. Foreign-Trade Zones (FTZ) Board held a hearing on a pending subzone application for MPM Silicones, LLC (MPM). The hearing was requested by a domestic supplier to MPM, who asserted that MPM's use of an FTZ could circumvent antidumping policy. This type of hearing has not been held by the Board for many years. comment period for the case was extended to June 6, 2007, to allow for submission of comments after the public hearing. 72 Fed.
