DOJ EXPORT ENFORCEMENT

In a June 11 speech, Attorney General Alberto Gonzales announced a U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) national export enforcement initiative prosecute violations of U.S. export control laws. Steve Pelak, an 18-year DOJ veteran, has been appointed the first National Export Control Coordinator. This position will be responsible for training prosecutors nationwide coordinating with other government agencies on export enforcement.
