FTZ FTA PARITY BILL

The National Association of Foreign-Trade Zones (NAFTZ) worked in the NAFTA negotiations to get foreign-trade zones included in the "NAFTA territory" even though they are not included in the U.S. Customs territory. This allows FTZs to be used to manufacture NAFTAqualifying product for sale in Mexico or Canada. Legislation prepared by the NAFTZ has now been introduced by Rep. Bill Pascrell (D-NJ) that would extend the benefits of all the free trade agreements to FTZs by allowing the manufacture of products for U.S. sale using FTA duty rates. The Wall Street Journal endorsed the legislation (H.R. 6415) in a Marshall Miller with questions.
