2008 TRADE DATA

- Customs has issued FY 2008 (10/1/07-9/30/08) trade statistics showing that while Customs entry volume decreased from 31.4 million entries to 31 million, value increased from \$2 trillion to \$2.2 trillion and duty collection increased from \$33 billion to \$34.5 billion. Note that declined entry/value data precipitously thereafter.
- The U.S. International Trade Commission (ITC) has released "Shifts in U.S. Merchandise Trade which illustrates that, 2008" despite the substantial downturn in trade during the last quarter, U.S. imports and exports of goods and services were up by 9% for the calendar year. USITC Pub. 4089 (July 2009).
- The U.S. ITC has also released "The Year in Trade 2008" focusing on the operation of various trade activities and programs. Highlights involve an 8% increase in exports to Free Trade Agreement (FTA) partners, constituting 38% of total U.S. exports, while imports of goods from FTA partners only increased 4.7%, or 30% of total U.S. Bureau of Industry and Security additional funding for ACE and imports. Excluding NAFTA trade, the trade surplus with FTA partners increased from \$3.9 billion in 2007 to \$15.6 billion in 2008. USITC Pub. 4091 (July and recordkeeping violations. - Security (BIS) has posted its Annual Report to Congress for FY 2008 which provides a summation of BIS enforcement actions, their own internal export control on a compromise with the House regulatory changes, and export program, and not merely rely on on disclosure requirements for licensing statistics.
