



NEW PRODUCT EXCLUSIONS - CHINA SECTION 301 LISTS 1 AND 2 SEPTEMBER 28, 2019

On September 27, the United States Trade Representative (USTR) announced the latest round of approved product exclusions from China Section 301 [List 1](#) and [List 2](#) duties. These product exclusions are set forth in 92 and 111 new product-specific descriptions, respectively. They include certain engines, motors, machines, circuit board assemblies, switches, electrical connectors, bearings, surge protectors, etc.

The product exclusions from the China Section 301 duties are available for any importer for any product that falls within the special product description and enumerated ten-digit HTSUS classification. This is true regardless of whether the importer filed an exclusion request. Clients may also benefit through filing Post-Summary Corrections or Protests for those entries now covered by a List 1, 2, or 3 product exclusion to secure refunds plus interest. List 1 product exclusions are retroactive to July 6, 2018, and List 2 product exclusions are retroactive to August 23, 2018.
