



SECTION 232 STEEL AND ALUMINUM DERIVATIVE LISTS

Late on January 27, 2020, the Department of Commerce released [Annex I](#) and [Annex II](#) to a Presidential Proclamation issued on January 24, 2020 imposing Section 232 duties on steel (25%) and aluminum (10%) derivative products. For further discussion on the process used to enact these duties, please review our previous [comments](#).

Annex I covers aluminum stranded wire, cables, plaited bands, bumper stampings for motor vehicles, and body stampings for tractors. Annex II lists steel nails, tacks, drawing pins, corrugated nails, bumper stampings for motor vehicles, and body stampings for tractors. These duties will go into effect on February 8, 2020.
