## **USTR - EUROPEAN UNION - LARGE CIVIL AIRCRAFT DISPUTE** PROPOSED U.S. RELATIATORY DUTIES

The U.S. Trade Representative (USTR) has issued proposed lists of 317 HTSUS subheading classifications valued at \$11 billion that could be subject to additional duties of up to 100% in retaliation for the European Union's failure to implement World Trade Organization (WTO) Dispute Settlement Body recommendations related to WTOinconsistent subsidies and other measures related to large commercial (i.e., Airbus) aircraft.

The proposed HTSUS lists include not only EU-origin civilian aircraft, helicopters, and parts thereof, but also fish, cheese, wine, textiles, carpets, apparel, women's handbags, dinnerware, ceramics, glassware, wall clocks, knives, tools, artist brushes, motorcycles, binoculars, and other items. Clients should review the proposed lists in the Federal Register carefully for potential impact. Requests to appear at a May 15 hearing are due on May 6 and public comments are due on May 28. 84 Fed. Reg. 15028 (Apr. 12, 2019).
